Minutes of Last Meeting

Discussion of Interim Report on Automated Facial Recognition

2. The Panel discussed the key issues under consideration in the draft of its interim report on automated facial recognition technology, which will be focussing on the Met's trials. There was a detailed discussion of the 'gateway' for public participation in the trial; the public's awareness of the trial and consent to participate; and the possible implications if individuals choose not to participate.
